- Develop a greater understanding of working with individual differences (with a focus on dyslexia)
- Explore the importance of creating a 'safe space'
- Anti-oppressive and anti-racist PE practice

Enabling and assessing

- Reflective supervision
- Promoting resilience and self-care
- Explore the importance of providing feedback
- Importance of PLE feedback- triangulation of evidence in assessments

Struggling placements

- Raising concerns- courageous conversations
- Developing SMART action plans
